Community Foundation Awards \$69,970 in Scholarships

This spring Central Alabama Community Foundation (CACF) awarded 41 scholarships totaling \$69,970 to deserving students at each of their schools' awards presentations. Scholarships are available through the Foundation to students specifically in Autauga, Elmore, Houston, Lowndes, Montgomery, and Pike counties with a few scholarships open to applicants statewide. Elmore County Community Foundation, an affiliate of CACF, awarded 71 scholarships totaling \$104,932. CACF's Wiregrass affiliate, the Southeast Alabama Community Foundation, awarded an additional \$16,100 to students in that region.

"Congratulations to this year's recipients. We would also like to thank the donors that make these awards possible. Establishing a scholarship fund with CACF is an investment in the future," said CACF President Burton U. Ward.
